



QUALIFYING COUNTRIES

A performance will only be deemed as qualifying if it took place in a qualifying territory or at a time when you were a citizen/subject of or a resident in a qualifying territory.

A territory is a qualifying territory if it is a Member State of the EU or if it is a "designated territory" - that is, if it has been designated by the UK government as enjoying reciprocal protection under UK law, by virtue of the rights performers receive in that country.

A list of Member States and designated territories is set out below.
